Outpouring of the Spirit in India!

Thanks so much for your prayers and support of Mission: India. We had some wonderful meetings, but also some tremendous challenges. Praise God who (to use the words of Paul) delivered us out of the mouth of the lion!



About Abohar: - We have never been so far north in India. There are very few Christians in India, with believers comprising about 2% of the population. But most of these are concentrated in the southern part of the nation. The farther north you go, the fewer believers there are. This is true to such an extent that Indian Christians from the south sometimes move up north as missionaries. In Abohar, we were almost as far north as you can get, and were also a very short distance from the India / Pakistan border.



Bible Prophecy Conference:

Our Conference for believers was centered on the theme of the return of our Lord Jesus. Dennis taught on the fundamental concepts of the Rapture of the Church, the book of Revelation, and the Biblical preponderance of references to Christ's return. The Christians rarely get teaching about the rapture of the church and the 2nd coming of Jesus, and eagerly drank in the teachings. Benedicta shared her powerful testimony of how Jesus healed her of typhoid and malaria and saved her while in high school, and was hugely popular, especially with the Indian ladies .



Outpouring of the Spirit in India!

Evening Evangelism: We had evening meetings in a public hall. There was a rich anointing of the Holy Spirit, and it was easy for Dennis and Benedicta to minister in such an atmosphere. Praise God for the Holy Spirit! At the invitation it was impossible to separate the believers from the non-believers, as there was a huge surge of nearly all the people present, eager to come to the front and publicly confess Jesus Christ. The Gospel of Jesus Christ did not go forth "in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance."



Detained at Police Station: A local Hindu saw Dennis preaching and got some of his buddies together to protest a "foreigner" preaching Christ in their town. Dennis and Benedicta were detained a couple of hours and then were released, but the police kept their passports. Conditions seemed to worsen at the hotel and finally Dennis and Benedicta, with their coordinator John Ishmael and a local believer decided to flee in the night to avoid a possible attack or re-imprisonment, even without their passports. Finally the passports were released and the local pastor met Dennis' group in a quiet spot along the highway about a half an hour out of town and returned the passports.

A joyous meeting in the night, when Dennis & Benedicta's passports were returned.
