*We praise God for the opportunity to lift up our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in Nansana, Uganda. Nansana is a suburb / village on the outskirts of Kampala. Benedicta and I ministered here as a team and found the people of Nansana very much open to hear the word of the Lord. We preached in outdoor evangelistic meetings in the evenings and held conferences for believers in the mornings.*



*In the small community of Nansana Town there is an extremely high concentration of Muslims. The Christian churches are small and are greatly outnumbered by Muslim mosques. Other than attempting to block us from renting the field for outdoor evangelism, the Muslims did not bother us. In fact some of them actually showed up at the meetings and seemed to enjoy themselves. We heard a number of reports of Muslims who gave their lives to Christ. We praise God for the power of the gospel to open blind eyes, and turn men and women to the truth.*

**Invitations**—We still give old fashioned invitations to one and all to come forward and receive Jesus Christ. We have counselors who will get their names and addresses, so that they can be followed up by a pastor or church leader. We praise God for the people who responded and for testimonies afterwards of changed lives and new folks who showed up in the local churches on Sunday. It is our desire not merely to make converts, but to make disciples—men and women who will join local churches, study the Word of God, and become true followers of Jesus Christ.



We wanted to bless pastors with bicycles, particularly those who had to walk long distances to get to their churches. Originally we budgeted to give out four bikes to pastors, but due to the generosity of our supporters, we were able to give away nine bicycles. There are pastors happily bicycling around Uganda -- because you care!



We feel called of God to bless and equip African pastors. In addition to our morning conferences, this also involves providing resources.
